JUNIOR SURF REGISTRATION

Our registration process has changed to an online system.

This sheet outlines the two-step process for new members and the one-step process for those who have previously registered.

If you're unable to register online, have questions, need assistance with the registration process, or lack access to a credit card, please email whakatane@surf.org.nz for assistance.

STEP 1 OF THE REGISTRATION PROCESS: Register with Surf Life Saving NZ (SLSNZ)

- This is a free process and is for insurance purposes.
- **All members are required to register online through the Surf Life Saving NZ (SLSNZ) website. This is important as every member needs to have a SLSNZ identification number.**

- Scroll down to **COMPLETE SLSNZ MEMBERSHIP**

- Search Whakatane as the club you want to join and complete the membership application.
- Ensure you register under the name of the person (child) joining. Each child needs to be registered separately.
- SLSNZ will advise us of your new membership registration, and we can match this to Step 2.

STEP 2 OF THE REGISTRATION PROCESS: Register with Whakatane Surf Life Saving Club

- Click on **Register**, select **New to Whakatane SLSC**, select **Junior Surf 5 – 15-Year-Olds**, and complete the registration form.

- Junior Surf membership fees for the season are \$40.00 per child. You will be required to make payment via Stripe once you have completed the form.
- For new members, it is compulsory to have a Whakatane SLSC vest; if you cannot source second-hand options, these can be purchased at the club for \$20.
